**Under this agreement for 2016
Murgon State High School will receive**

\$259,288*

This funding will be used to

- Lift the percentage of Years 7 and 9 students achieving NMS in Reading NAPLaN from 81% to >90 %
- Lift the percentage of Year 7 students achieving NMS in Writing NAPLaN from 42% to >80%.
- Lift the percentage of Years 7 and 9 students NMS in Numeracy NAPLaN from 88% to 93%.
- Lift the percentage of students achieving Cs or above in English, Maths and Science Years 8, 9 and 10 from < 70% to > 80%
- Lift school attendance data from 82% to > 89%
- Lift Year 12 QCE/QCIA attainment outcomes from 68.5% to >92%.
- Close the Gap in indigenous QCE attainment – lift QCE attainment from 40% to 95% attainment.
- Reduce short School Disciplinary Absences from 340 incidents per annum to < 250.

Our initiatives include

- Implementing the Literacy Enhancement Action Plan (LEAP) for students not achieving NMS in reading in Years 7 and 9
 - Analysing NAPLAN data to identify gaps in learning and focus teaching around Australian Curriculum outcomes
 - Targeting Years 7 and 9 students on the NMS and U2B cusp in NAPLAN Reading, Writing and Numeracy
 - Using of online learning support to lift A-E results in Junior secondary Maths, English and Science.
- Collaborating with Year 5 and 6 teachers and Murgon High Year 7 English and Maths teachers to ensure alignment of teaching and learning strategies addressing gaps identified in analysing NAPLAN results
- Case managing all students at-risk of not attaining either a QCE or QCIA
- Providing additional administrative support in data literacy and senior pathways case management
- Reviewing senior secondary assessment and curriculum especially in vocational education to increase pathways for all students, including QCE at-risk Indigenous students.
- Targeted behaviour management to reduce conflict and disengagement.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Implementing targeted support in reading following analysis of Literacy Enhancement Action Plan (LEAP) outcomes to ascertain reading levels of all students and allowing identify specific areas for improvement.
- Implementing targeted intervention after interrogating 2016 NAPLAN results in Reading to identify students on NMS and U2B threshold
- Implementing data literacy project to identify gaps in learning from NAPLAN results and focusing teaching around pertinent Australian Curriculum
- Implementation of online learning support *Education Perfect* to lift A-E results in Junior secondary Maths, English and Science.

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- Facilitating a 2 day workshop with Year 5/ 6 teachers from all feeder primary schools and MSHS Year 7 English and Maths teachers to ensure alignment of teaching and learning strategies that address gaps identified by NAPLAN analysis
- Implementing targeted behaviour management initiatives dealing with increasing social skills, conflict resolution and resilience
 - Implementing senior pathways through targeted case management of **all** Year 12 QCE students in order lift attainment outcomes, including provision of additional administrative support
- Reviewing senior assessment and curriculum to enable greater choice especially VET options
